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### Innovate for Impact: The Design Thinking Workshop

The Design Thinking Workshop, "Innovate for Impact: Crafting Strategic Skill Sets for KASE Workforce Excellence," was held from 19th to 21st September 2024 at Uday Suites, Trivandrum, organized by Kerala University of Digital Sciences, Innovation and Technology. This three-day event aimed to equip participants with essential corporate, technological, and design thinking skills to address workplace challenges. The workshop began with an introduction by Prof. Santhosh Kurup from Digital University of Kerala, followed by an address from Shri. Vinod T. V, COO of KASE.
