Monthly Report on Centrally Sponsored Projects: DECEMBER 2020

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2.0

The training related activities under the scheme were suspended since 12th March 2020 due to the pandemic. The trainings restarted on 3rd December 2020. The setting up of Training Centres as per SOP has been verified by KASE PMU via video verification. Subsequently, Training centers (69 nos) commenced the trainings.

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 3.0

As part of the implementation of PMKVY 3.0 Scheme, a meeting with all District Collectors, under the chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Labour and Skills was convened 03.12.2019. Managing Director, KASE convened the same. The meeting discussed the role of District Skill Committees in PMKVY 3.0 scheme.

Coordination with Other Departments:

1. Advocacy and Awareness Workshop on Awarding Body and Assessment Agency Guidelines National Council for Vocational Education and Training conducted an Advocacy and Awareness Workshop on Awarding Body and Assessment Agency Guidelines on 07.12.2020. KASE Coordinated the same in Kerala by disseminating the information to other stakeholders in skilling ecosystem viz; Industrial Training Department, Additional Skills Acquisition Programme (ASAP), Kudumbashree, VHSE and Training Partners

Skills Acquisition and Knowledge Enhancement for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP): Mahatma Gandhi National Fellowship – Signing of Memorandum of Understanding with Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship – Reg.

KASE signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) regarding the implementation of Mahatma Gandhi National Fellowship (MGNF) in Kerala, as part of 'SANKALP' Project - a World Bank funded initiative of MSDE. The two-year Mahatma Gandhi National Fellowship (MGNF) programme is designed to address the challenge in terms of unavailability of strong institutional mechanisms at the district level. The programme seeks to create a cadre of individuals, and train them in a blended academic program that provides both academic inputs and field level immersion at district level. This shall contribute to the creation of a district level ecosystem to support skill development.
